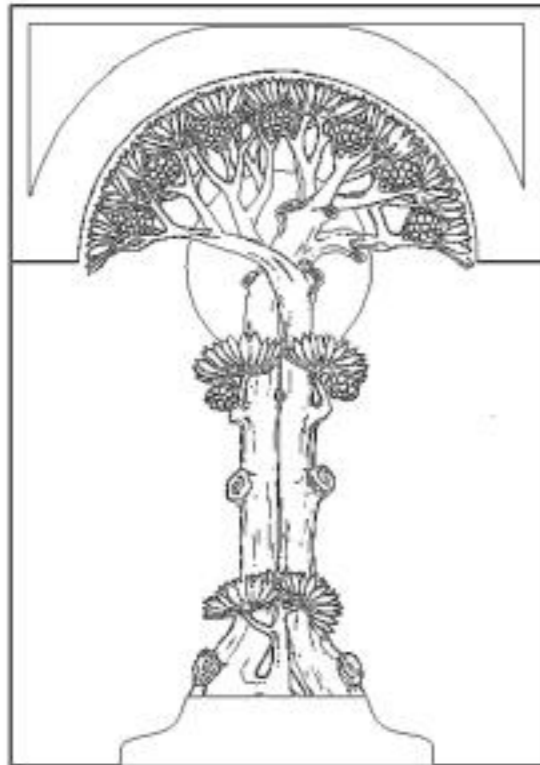


Welcome to the Autumn Semester

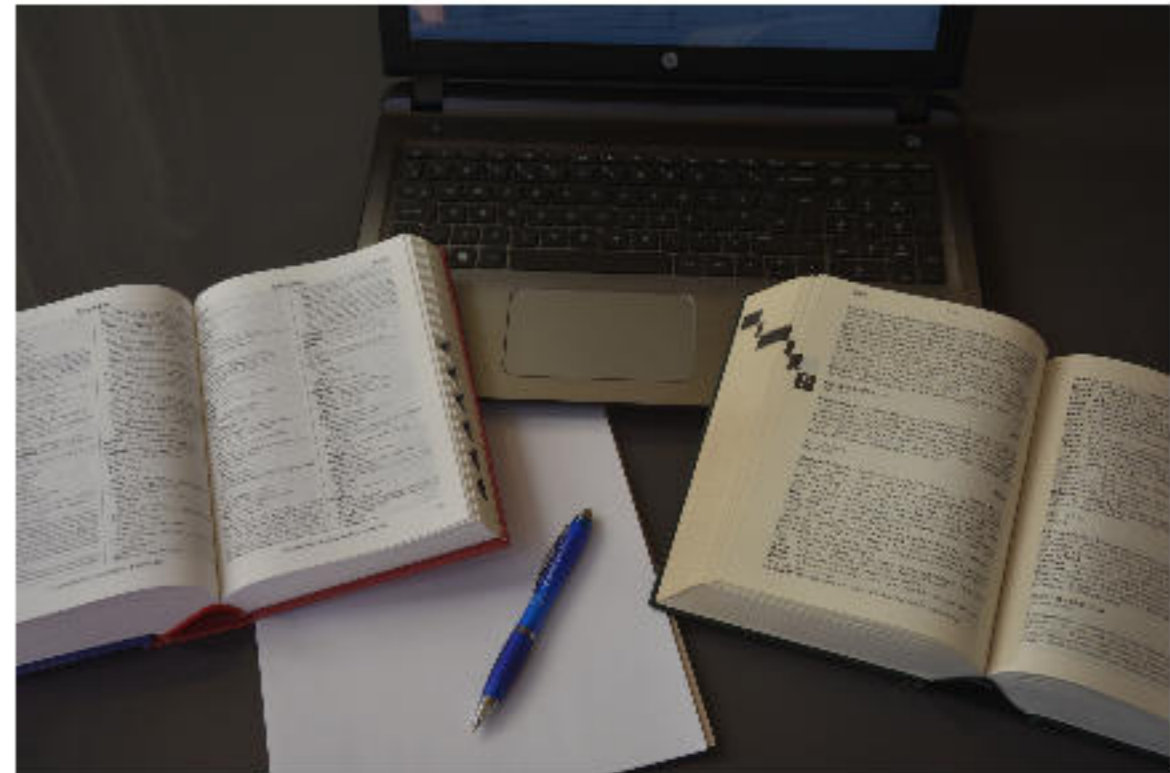

In the spring semester we covered clinical aspects of homeopathic practice, including:

- Prescribing strategies
- Potency choice, posology
- Review choices and considerations
- Tracking responses to treatment
- The Second prescription
- Introduction to Kentian Repertorisation and
- Boenninghausen, Therapeutic Pocket Book



The Spring Semester covered the content using:

1. Case Studies on Video supported with additional case documentation.
2. Set reading using extracts and recommended companion textbooks
3. Support Material on Therapeutics / Applied Principles of Practice.
4. Tutorials / Presentations (Week 12)
5. Supervised case-taking sessions (Week 11)
6. Assessed learning activities - repertorisation - (Weeks 9 & 10)

Changes In the Autumn Semester

Each clinical case will be condensed to run over 2 weeks.

Participants are asked to commit to a treatment decision prior to the weekly tutorial.

There will be less set reading than last semester. (Now typically 2-3 pages per week) but keeping up with this set reading is essential in the Autumn semester in order to follow and contribute to the case discussions.

There will be a move away from didactic teaching / learning towards Collaborative Group Learning, involving activities which support materia medica studies.

The experiential learning in week 11/12 will involve one of the following:

- a) supervised case taking (closed to other participants)
- b) presentation and discussion of one of the participant's own clinical cases.
- c) presentation on a remedy, or a homeopathic topic of participant's own choosing.

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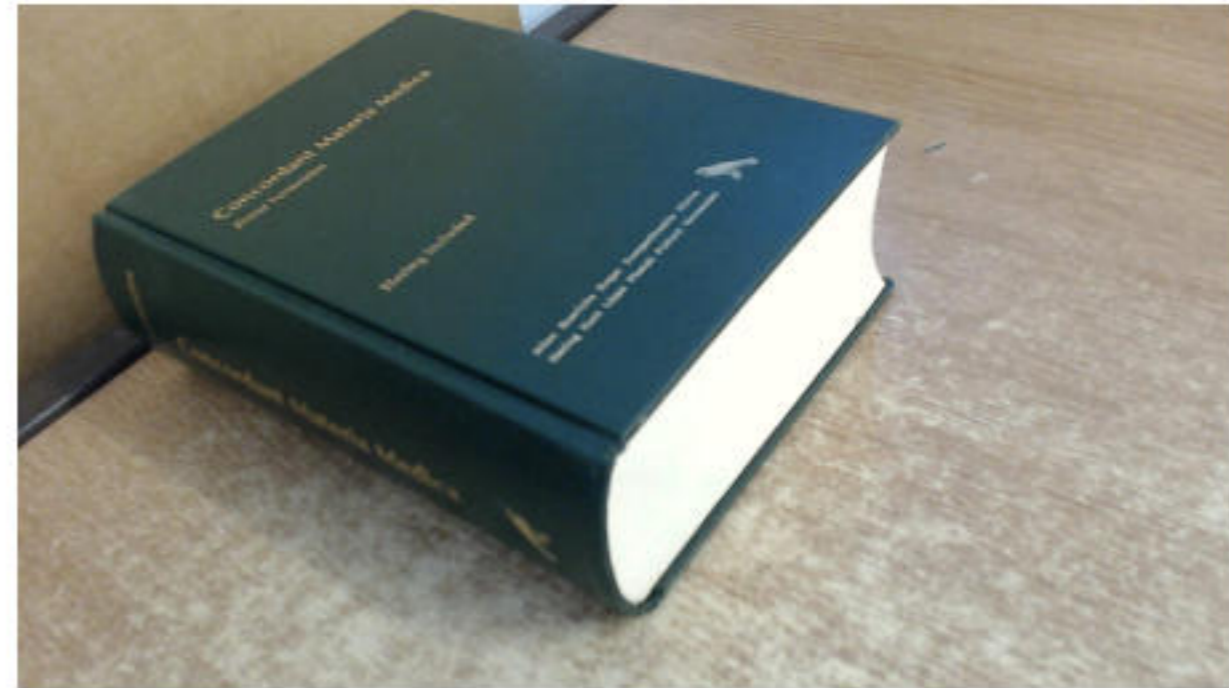
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
