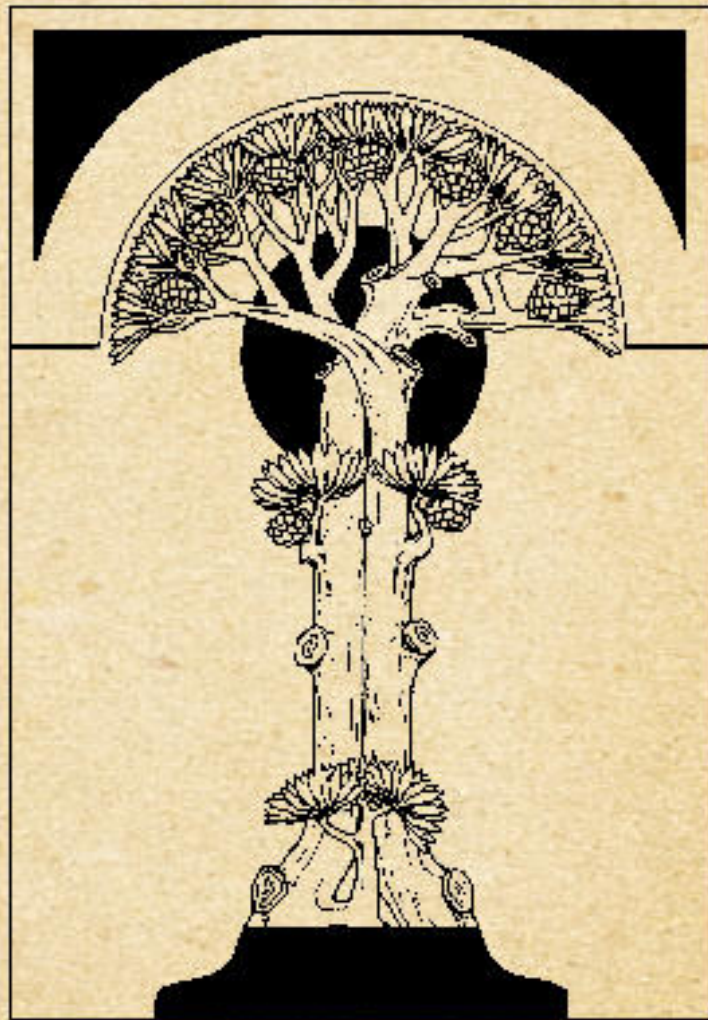

Finds classroom too hot. Windows open a lot.

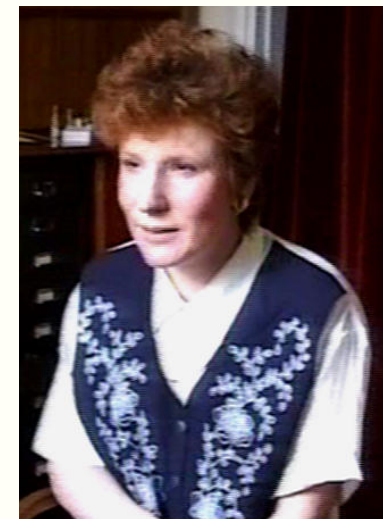
