Guidance Notes

The Intermediate Course is structured differently from the Foundation Course. Up to this point we have touched on many topics with the aim of providing you with an overview. From here onwards we wish to deepen your understanding. We hope that an increasing critical awareness of the basic concepts will help you apply some new treatment methods with insight, accuracy and effectiveness in a widening range of conditions.

We have selected a number of texts that are appropriate to this level of study and which are currently available in general publication. We do provide some pointers to obtaining these texts.

There are a number of set course readers for the rest of your studies and some of these are essential to the First Semester (asterisked in the list below)

Although you were provided with a free pdf of the *Organon* in your Foundation materials, we recommend that you now purchase the recommended translation to get the best out of the conceptual discussions in Semester 1 and 2.

Polarity Analysis is proving to be an effective method of case analysis and on-line reference resources are available that will help you to gather some of the most important case information required by this method. To begin with, many of your cases are amenable to pattern recognition using the materia medica keynotes that you learned in your Foundation Course. As your Intermediate studies progress we will introduce repertorisation techniques and you will have an opportunity to apply these in the virtual clinic sessions. You should obtain a physical copy of a repertory to make the best of these sessions. Some participants prefer to invest in a computerised repertory at an early stage, others prefer to study the technique of repertorisation and are content with manual analysis using Synthesis (see below) to begin with.

Some participants at this stage have already purchased *Morrison's Desktop Companion*. Others are using *Phatak's Materia medica* (see Foundation Reading List for further details) These texts will continue to serve you well at Intermediate Level. If you wish to purchase a more extensive text that will continue to serve you in your later studies, you may wish to consider Franz Vermeulen's *Concordant Materia Medica*.

The two other materia medicas previously listed are by Catherine Coulter and George Vithoulkas. These are supplemental reading and they reflect a particular perspective on a limited range of remedies. They are not reference texts as such but are often found to be useful as conceptual aids to the study of essences and constitutional presentations.
