Materia Medica Studies

This is the section of Part 1 in which we study the materia medica and therapeutic indications of an important homeopathic remedy.

The topic of this section is the remedy *Arsenicum album*. Arsenicum is what we call a polychrest remedy, because it has an extensive symptom picture and its biological effects cross over several systems both in humans and in animal medicine.

This discussion begins with some notes on the toxicology of Arsenic and progresses to a description of its main homeopathic indicating features and symptoms.

The remedy has been in the materia medica for centuries long before Hahnemann revised the indications for its safe homeopathic use.

You should take careful note of the mind picture for this remedy, since although it has several useful pathological indications, it is also an important material in the treatment of anxiety.

Arsenicum album (White oxide of arsenic)



Regions most affected:

Skin, Bowel, Peripheral nerves, and most tissues to a greater or lesser extent

Ailments from:

Spoiled food, alcohol abuse, viral infection, worry, grief, fright.

Generals:

- Burning pains often better for heat
- Great chilliness, lack of vital heat Weakness, and often emaciation
- Symptoms which are recurrent or relapsing at regular intervals
- **Thirst** for cold drinks, small sips of water frequently
- Inflammation of mucous membranes with thin acrid discharges
- Acute diarrhoea can be copious, watery and exhausting

Mind symptoms:

- **Anxiety** -especially concerning his/her health,
- · Great fear and restlessness
- Fastidiousness
- **Obsessive** personality to the point of being ritualistic
- They imagine that every tiny symptom heralds severe illness like cancer or heart disease.

Modalities:

- < Periodically, especially at night after 2am
- < Lying with the head low
- > External heat, warm wraps
- > Motion, walking about

Clinical uses:

- Painful vesicular eruptions, eg herpes zoster
- Pain syndromes characterised by **burning sensations**, post herpetic neuralgia
- **Gastroenteritis**: diarrhoea vomiting and prostration Anxiety states with obsessive ideas concerning illness
- Asthma, with **nocturnal aggravation**, restlessness and anxiety
