These two papers provide a framework for modeling painful intercourse. There is a telling quote from the first paper:

'An individualized, holistic, and often multidisciplinary approach is needed to effectively manage the woman's pain and pain-related distress.'

As you read these articles you will come to understand that sympathetic and complete history-taking is essential, together with appropriate examination and investigation. The picture rarely yields a simple explanation for the symptomatology.

Opposite is their summary for an integrated management approach. It is a helpful summary, but does not fully explain how integrated care is achieved in conventional practice.

Homeopathic history taking is extremely valuable in that it allows for areas of crossover for emotional, hormonal, organic, anatomical, behavioural, interpersonal understandings which together can provide a basis for an individualised response.
