The Lanthanides as a Remedy Group -

Introduction by Russell Malcolm

In terms of their overarching ideas, the *Lanthanides* embody a set of attractive attributes (that some homeopaths feel they must have a personal affinity to!)

In contrast to the prosaic and practical side of the Iron series, the *Lanthanides* can appear free and independent, yet they can also quickly pick up practical skills.

In contrast to the focus on performance and the potentially attentionseeking behaviours of the Silver series, the *Lanthanides* can appear to have a quieter and more natural talent.

In contrast to the organisational skills of the Gold series, the *Lanthanides* can appear more individual, independent and less tied to structures and rules.

In contrast to the somewhat hazy 'spirituality' of the gases, the *Lanthanides* can appear more orientated and wise in their beliefs, without necessarily being tied to one particular dogma or philosophy.

In contrast to many of the salts, with their relational issues - which are often either too tightly bound, or too loose and unstable - the *Lanthanides* often appear self reliant, particularly concerning their own needs, yet they some are also caring and helpful to others. They can become powerfully skilled therapists.

There are qualities carried over from the themes of all the earlier rows and yet, for all the strengths in the *Lanthanide* makeup, these patients are prone to autoimmune illness - with the 'loss of self-recognition' we might recognise in the Carcinosin picture.

Their uniqueness can sometimes result in a detachment from society, as they 'plough their own furrow' and, at its most pathological, some commentators feel their 'singularity' can verge on the autistic. Scholten interprets the phenomenon differently, as you will hear in the interview extract linked below.
