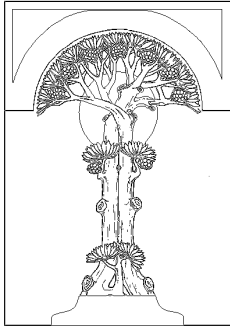

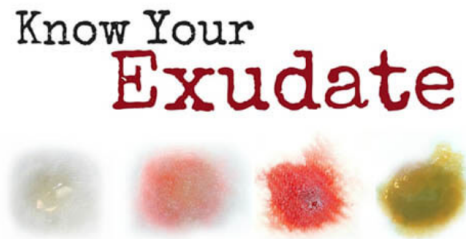
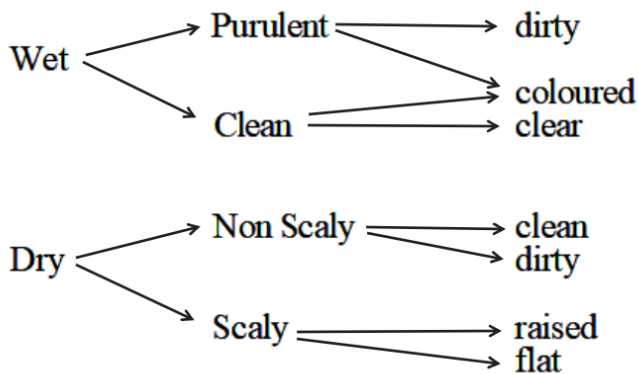

Phenomenological Types of eczema: Acute, Chronic, Wet or dry.

Eczema P1312. 20 remedies in black types.

Preliminary:

Clearing Remedies: *Morgan bach 30c, Sulphur 200c.*

Clearing Steroids: *Nux Vomica 6c + 1 dose Cortisone 200 or Nux Vomica then Thuja.*

Treatment:

Wet Purulent *Merc Sol 200, Creosote 6c, Hepar Sulph 30*

Wet Clean, coloured *Phosphorus 3c or Cicuta Virosa 6c*

Wet Clean, clear *Sulphur Iodatium 6c, Lycopodium 30 (chronic)*

Dry Non scaly, clean *Graphites 6c, Primula 6c, Arsen Alb 30*

Dry Non scaly, dirty *Medorrhinum, Syphilinum*

Dry Scaly - raised *Psorinum 200c, Petroleum 6c, Nat Mur 30c, Rhus Tox 30c, Thuja 30c, Ant Crud 6c*

Dry Scaly - flat *Sulphur 6c, Belladonna 30, Selenium 30c*

Some Common Remedies in more detail - Thermal Modalities, *Arsenicum album & Ars. Iodatium*

The use of NOSODES in eczema cases (eg. Staphylococcal Nosode)

Veterinarian

Eczema of the Ears & Ear flap: *Merc Solubilis, Tellurium, Arsenicum Iodatium, Causticum.*

Cats Miliary Eczema: *Ovarium folliculinum, Oestrogens in low potency, Ustilago*

Fleas & Eczema: *Sulphur, Echinacea.*
